FOR WORLD DEMOCRACY

FROM coast to coast, the flame of patriotism has burned high in the hearts of hundreds of fraternity men during these history-making months since the United States government declared itself at war with the German nation. Hundreds of active members and alumni of Sigma Alpha Epsilon have left their homes and their fraternity halls to answer the call to the colors. One will find them now at the front, or in training camps, forts, and cantonments, at aviation schools, in hospital and ambulance corps, in Red Cross work, and in Army and Navy Y. M. C. A. work, on the decks of battleships, in conning tower or wireless room, everywhere that duty calls, and special training finds its work to do.

So many have gone that the younger brothers left behind find it a severe tax to keep up the chapters, but they are making the necessary sacrifices gladly and with the spirit of serving our country in her hour of need. There is little danger of Brother Levere's remark last spring finding an application: "A full chapter-house next year will be a disgrace to any fraternity."

"Billy" himself has gone, along with 1,600 other men of our Fraternity whose names are all tabulated in his office in Evanston, and doubtless many others whom we will hear from later. "William C. Levere, French Army Y. M. C. A." is the way he signed himself writing back from New York just before sailing, with the name of Eric Dawson, Mississippi Gamma, also French Army Y. M. C. A., on the same hotel letter-head. Levere is now "somewhere in

France," for a message received September 28 stated that he had arrived safely on the other side. His going means that his work falls to other hands; Marvin E. Holderness, with his wide experience and thorough grasp of fraternity matters, is acting Eminent Supreme Recorder. The writer received a telegram from Billy saying that he was sailing for France, and offering the pleasant task of writing this article. He and his office staff in Evanston had the voluminous data on file, else it would be an impossible task. Speaking of his office staff, Walter Olin is at Fort Riley, Kansas, and he and Jay Richardson write that there are about fifty to seventy-five Σ A Es there. Clyde Brown, who enlisted in the navy, going from the office of the E. S. R., is seeing actual service on the U. S. S. *Delaware*, and believes he can make the Northwestern football team when he gets back. The office work goes on just the same, but it means night and day work sometimes for Miss Katherine Mullen, the Σ A E clerk.

The list of 1,600 names published herewith is one of which any fraternity might be proud. Sigma Alpha Epsilon is proud of it, for it is evidence beyond any doubt of the spirit of her sons, the spirit that is ready to make any sacrifice necessary to defend the nation's honor and to uphold President Wilson in his declaration that it is the part of free-born Americans to aid in making the world safe for liberty-loving peoples who are to come in future generations. Most of the men whose names appear in this roll of honor offered themselves voluntarily for service; and being in some branch of the military or naval service when college opened, they did not return to college. Scores of others, eligible as to age and physical condition, held themselves in readiness, and have been called already, or will be called, in the conscription quotas. On his visitation trip to the chapters last spring, Brother Levere sounded the active members of the Fraternity on this subject, and found that the majority of fraternity members have the opinion that conscription is right in principle and will work justly in practice.

"We want to go with 'the first ten thousand,'" wrote the chapter at Stanford, in reporting the number of their men who had gone. "All of our boys but two are in the special training camp, and the age limit is what keeps these two from entering."

Sam Woods, Eminent Archon of Oklahoma Kappa Chapter, wrote to Brother Levere in place of the Eminent Correspondent, who had enlisted, that he had to appoint new committees at every meeting

because of the incumbents joining army or navy. "We have twenty-two men in different branches of the service," he wrote, "some have gone to the navy, some to the training camps, some to the national guard, and some to the regular army for the period of the war. We are justly proud of every one of them, but, Billy, those who are left behind are going to keep things going, and we will be here when we are of most use and the nation calls."

As long ago as April 26, Maine Alpha reported: "The following men have left Orono for war service: A. J. Tierney, Merle Wescott, F. J. Penley, H. B. Hiller, D. Campbell, V. O. Harkness, E. A. Bradley, C. A. R. Lewis, and T. W. Brittain. Others are expecting to leave soon." Bradley and Harkness are members of the 2nd Maine Infantry, and with thirty-two other Maine men constitute the band of which that university is proud. Drill for three hours a day is a part of the curriculum for the men still in college.

Wisconsin, Dickinson, Nevada, North Carolina, and other universities are also emphasizing military training, and students who remain in college are getting the drill that will fit them for active service the instant they are called.

From the baby chapter at Arizona come the following six names of those who enlisted and left on the first call: Harry E. Turvey, Ira N. Gilbert, Harold L. Pierce, Thomas O. Marlar, Charles E. Barkley, and Julius R. Bush.

Six active men and five alumni of Arkansas Alpha-Upsilon entered the Reserve Officers' Training Camp at Fort Logan H. Roots, Little Rock. The alumni were Roy Stockburger, H. S. Dunn, H. W. Bryan, F. R. Garner, Jr., and W. E. Bradford. From the chapter went A. B. Armstrong, E. H. Cheever, F. D. Pape, C. L. Skaggs, W. P. Warner, and L. P. Illing.

Eight of Illinois Psi-Omega's men, K. L. Anderson, F. B. Ingram, W. R. D. Brightmire, O. L. Reeve, Walter E. Olin, D. B. Yoder, A. G. Bradt, and Jay Richardson, enlisted for the officers' training camps, and Douglas Smith enlisted in Co. D of the 1st Illinois Infantry.

Ten brothers of the Alabama Polytechnic chapter at Auburn filed applications for training camps on the first call, and Cumberland responded likewise. Homer B. Johnson, W. Arley Munts, and James F. Gardner of the active chapter at the latter university entered the training camp at Ft. Oglethorpe, Georgia, and Neil Reed that at Ft. Logan H. Roots, Arkansas. Of the alumni, the

following also went into the Ft. Oglethorpe training camp: James R. Tubb, Jr., B. C. Brown, J. R. Tedder, W. D. Hudson, Herbert H. Moses, and Sam L. Gordon. They report about fifty brothers at that fort.

Oregon Alpha sent eight of her best men: Harry S. Pinkerton to the navy, Reno M. Banks to the cavalry, and the following to the Reserve Officers' Training Corps—Olaf R. Jonasen, William I. Wakeman, James T. Stephens, Hugh M. Reynolds, James H. Clark, and Charles L. Sefrit.

In the Medical Corps of Ft. Slocum, New York, the Bucknell chapter is represented by J. A. Heberling, and at Ft. Niagara there are four men from that chapter: H. S. Hopler, R. C. Umlauf, S. J. Peale, and A. L. Rummer.

Texas Rho answered the first call by sending fourteen of her best men in a body to the training camp at Leon Springs, Texas.

An incomplete unofficial list of Σ A Es at Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indianapolis, supplied by Richard H. Hobbe, Illinois Beta, 12th Co., 9th Div., included besides himself, Al F. Leue, former E. S. D. A., of Ohio Epsilon Chapter; Everson of Indiana, now a major; and Bull of New York, a captain, in the 3rd Co., 8th Div.; H. N. Findley, Case '17, of the same company; Strahm of Kentucky, 12th Co., 9th Div.; R. E. Johnson of Illinois Beta; W. F. Joplin and Russell Heyworth, Indiana Beta, Co. D, 8th Div.; P. L. Hurley, also from Purdue, in Co. F, 8th Div.; Jones of Kentucky State, Co. D, 8th Div.; Lowery of Indiana Alpha in the same company, and also Brothers Hill and Whit Spiegel of Purdue.

Brother Leue was commissioned a lieutenant in the Quartermasters' Corps in August, and detailed to Ft. Sherman.

Wm. S. Storey of Tennessee Omega reports that thirty-nine brothers were registered up to July 4 at the Ambulance Corps Y. M. C. A., Allentown, Pennsylvania; they flocked there from the four corners of the Union as will be seen from the following list: Carl J. Stevens and Caldwell S. Phillips of Maine Alpha; Fred W. Gee and Geo. H. Smith, Jr., of New Hampshire Alpha; O. B. Dahm, A. H. Nall, B. K. Pancoast, U. U. Beville, and H. G. Powell of Florida Upsilon; M. K. Smith and J. C. Lestheim of Virginia Omicron; L. P. Collins, Jr., and John W. Cook, Jr., of Virginia Sigma; J. K. Hamm, Mississippi Gamma; Keinerton Dean, Massachusetts Iota-Tau; Wm. Roos, Jno. G. Heinz, and A. L. Stoehlke, Massachusetts Gamma; P. E. Meier, Missouri Beta; C. E. Hamilton,

Iowa Beta; J. K. Tellier, Iowa Gamma; F. C. Bell, F. M. Reed, and J. T. Frey, Michigan Iota-Beta; C. H. Crego, Jr., Tennessee Eta; R. R. Carney and Jno. A. Catlett, Tennessee Zeta; H. E. Clark, Stewart Phinizy, Jr., and W. S. Storey, Tennessee Omega; A. C. McIsaac, Alabama Alpha-Mu; Joseph H. Burdan, S. M. Free, Jr., and H. W. Adam, Pennsylvania Alpha-Zeta; Leroy G. Clark and Jno. B. Vanderbilt, Pennsylvania Zeta; J. D. Anderson, Pennsylvania Theta; Edward Bickel, Washington Alpha; and W. V. Heiss, Oregon Alpha.

George A. Gray, ordered to the Naval Medical School at Washington on May 21, writes to make certain that his RECORD will go to his Detroit address and to order an official service pin. He continues: "About seven of the seniors at Rush Medical College, Chicago, came down in this class of sixty-four. I thought for a while that I was the only Σ A E, but have so far run across Brother Murray from Indiana Alpha, Brother Groesbeck from University of Maryland, I believe, and Brother Myer from University of Pittsburgh." In June, after passing the examination for the regular service, Brothers Gray and Groesbeck were transferred to Philadelphia, and found in the service there Bros. T. R. Collier of Tennessee Nu and A. G. Whitfield of Illinois Theta.

The brothers enlisted in the Mosquito Fleet at Newport, some twenty in number, get together and have a little banquet now and then. Among others in this branch are H. S. Robinson, New Hampshire Alpha; Harold A. Waite, New York Delta; Arthur E. Koch, New York Sigma Phi; Bourke H. Bayless, Walter B. McGrew, Adrian T. Shannon, Stuart A. Read, Everett C. Read, William J. Clark, Ronald C. Van Atta, Paul Montgomery, George B. Healey, and Richard H. Swinton, New York Alpha. A part of Brother Bayless' account of the early days at Newport, while the matter of uniforms and tents was being worked out, makes interesting reading. "So far the bunch (of ten men from New York Alpha) has kept together in everything. As a usual thing we report about 8 o'clock in the morning for drill. Then it's wait—drill—wait—drill, for two or three hours before we return to town for lunch. Then at one-thirty we start drilling and waiting again, returning to town about four o'clock. We will not see any active service on the water for at least three weeks, perhaps longer. As yet we have no uniforms and no chance to get them until next week. The Army and Navy

Y. M. C. A. is our 'hang-out' for the present. Expect to be in the barracks or tents before long."

Beside the above New York Alpha men who enlisted in the Naval Reserve Fleet, many others responded to the nation's call in a way that will make the Cornell chapter's name a proud one as it goes down in history. McKiernan went into the Navy as a surgeon; Batts into the Aviation Corps; Munsick, Thompson, Sayles, and Winder into the Reserve Officers' Training Corps; George Robbins and Ernest Ling into the National Guard, assigned to ambulance training; Dawson Douglas, Colin Welles, and Taylor left college to do their bit in munition factories; Roberts went into shipbuilding; and five others, Barnes, Wilbur, Reynolds, Macrae, and Smith, went on farms to do their share of loyal work. "And the best part of it is," to quote Hamilton Roberts, who supplied this information, "that the house is fixed so that there is no danger of closing up, as there are enough good men who are ineligible for military service to keep the sacred flame still burning for New York Alpha."

Not all the chapters were so fortunate, however, in seeing their way clear toward keeping their houses open. Witness Wyoming Alpha. It was "rights to pistol pockets" with those boys. Six of them enlisted in the 3rd Wyoming Infantry and entrained for Camp Greene, at Charlotte, North Carolina, where they had the experience, strange for them, of digging stumps before they could pitch their tents. Bellamy and Fulton are sergeants in C Company, Stafford a sergeant in M Company, Asay a corporal in C Company, and Partridge and Laughlin are members of the regimental band. So many others went to the Presidio at San Francisco, or scattered to do their duty in raising wheat and beef for the soldiers, that only seven men were left in the chapter, and so the house in Laramie was closed. Harry Henderson wrote that he was raising a company, and that they hoped to be assigned to the Alaskan coast.

The faculty at the University of Kentucky having granted full credit for farm work last spring, sixty-five per cent of the student body left for farms. Kentucky Epsilon decided to close its house and take to agriculture, which it did, almost to a man.

Francis A. Schmidt of Nebraska Lambda-Pi writes from the training camp at Ft. Logan H. Roots that fifty-three loyal sons of Minerva gathered on the brow of the hill and had a photographer snap them. This being a war number of *THE RECORD*, the picture is not published. These brothers were mostly from Louisiana, Okla-

homa, Mississippi, Arkansas, and Tennessee. The Little Rock alumni did as much for the soldier Σ A Es as regulations would permit, an all-day picnic and a dance being among the forms of social entertainment.

Proud of her record during the Civil War, Washington City Rho has contributed of her best in this titanic struggle. Harry E. Petree and Allan E. Peck offered themselves for work in the aviation section and were sent to the Cadet School of Military Aeronautics at Massachusetts Institute of Technology for theoretical instruction. Afterward Brother Petree was ordered to Mineola, Long Island, to teach other fliers, while Brother Peck had his wish in being ordered to France as a first-class pilot. Ben Butterworth Dowell enlisted in the navy, and has gained the rank of junior lieutenant in the hydroplane squad at Pensacola, Florida. Jos. A. DuBois, who was a sergeant in the District of Columbia militia, entered the officers, reserve camp at Ft. Myer, Virginia, and is now serving in France as first lieutenant. W. A. Smith, Jr., and Louis D. Wine also entered for the training camp at Ft. Myer, while Frederick C. Calkins is at the Plattsburg, New York, camp. Allan F. Garner is a 2nd lieutenant in the cavalry and Leopold von Krentzlin, Fordyce H. Melvin, and Harold R. Northrup are stationed at Anniston, Alabama, with the respective ranks of captain, sergeant, and corporal. In the Ordnance Department, Corp. John Bullough, Jr., is serving "somewhere in France," and the following are stationed at the Quartermasters' Department Headquarters in Washington: 1st Lieut. Howard Dix, Sgt. Oliver H. Perry, Corps. James Patterson, James Duval, and Edwin K. LeFevre. In the Marines this chapter is represented by 2nd Lieuts. Luther W. Jones and Robert Kilmartin, and Pvt. Herman B. Le Vey.

The Rocky Mountain country furnished men for the Marines, as well, twin brothers, Clarence Thomson and Lawrence Thomson, the latter pledged but not yet initiated, volunteering at the University of Denver for that branch of the service. Otto Moore, president of the freshman class at Denver University, also volunteered in the Marines.

Bro. Don Johns, Illinois Beta, is an assistant paymaster in the navy, with the rank of ensign. Carl R. Gray, Jr., holds a captaincy in the Quartermasters' Reserve Corps.

Maj. James Norman Lease, Georgia Phi, was in charge of the construction of the cantonment at Atlanta, Georgia. Incidentally, he

is probably the youngest major in the service. In construction work also, Ackert Bickel, Arkansas Alpha-Upsilon, did his bit by supervising forty miles of trenching and pipe-laying at Ft. Riley, Kansas, a task accomplished in sixty days, probably the world's record for such work.

Beside losing Brother Levere, the fraternity has had to accept the resignations of one member of the Board of Trustees and of two province presidents, due to their military connections. Harry W. Hayward resigned as one of the trustees, since he was a member of the New York National Guard mustered into the Federal service on July 15. G. M. Alexander resigned as president of Province Gamma because of his membership in the National Guard. Ralph Bryan, president of Province Zeta, resigned in order to join the U. S. Army.

J. M. Parmelee, Massachusetts Gamma, is "over there" in France in the ambulance service, and as he is of THE RECORD staff, he may contribute some items later from close up to the trenches. Arthur Faster, Illinois Theta, is driving an ambulance for the American Ambulance Corps in France. H. Wynkoop Rubinkam, Illinois Theta, is also in France driving an ambulance. He has been decorated with the War Cross by General Gourand. An Associated Press dispatch published by the *Chicago Daily News* tells how the French general pinned the little bronze cross on the tunics of Rubinkam and three other ambulance drivers of Unit 13 in recognition of their courage and devotion in removing wounded men in bombardment. We clip the rest of the story:

"A reporter for *The Daily News* called on 'Little Hank's' mother, Mrs. Nathaniel Rubinkam, at her home, 1560 East 61st Street, and told her of the news in the Associated Press dispatch from Paris. And, while she tried not to show the tears of pride that welled to her eyes, she read 'Little Hank's' latest letter. It was dated June 5, at the front.

"'The Germans broke up our hospital,' read Mrs. Rubinkam, 'two weeks ago and many of our men were killed. Tom Cassady (Spencer, Indiana) was wounded in the head. I was with them all the time, but, luckily, was not hurt. There were several other ambulance boys on the job at the time, and this handful of American boys, excepting a French captain of the military division, were the only ones who stayed on the ground and took care of the wounded. The incident showed up the Americans well. Tom showed great pluck in taking a load to the hospital after he had been wounded. So that is the life of an ambulance man.'

"'Little Hank' Rubinkam told only of what Tom and the other fellows had done."

THE FRATERNITY IN THE WAR CONGRESS

THE present Congress is represented by more members of Sigma Alpha Epsilon than any previous Congress has contained. There are three senators and eight representatives, as follows:

Senators: J. C. W. Beckham, Kentucky, Kentucky Kappa, '88; Key Pittman, Nevada, Tennessee Zeta, '88; Philander C. Knox, Pennsylvania, Ohio Sigma, '72.

House of Representatives: S. Hubert Dent, Jr., Alabama, Alabama Iota, '86; Charles H. Brand, Georgia, Georgia Beta, '81; George H. Denton, Indiana, Ohio Delta, '91; Thomas U. Sisson, Mississippi, Tennessee Zeta, '89; Pat Harrison, Mississippi, Louisiana Epsilon, '02; Oscar Wm. Swift, New York, Michigan Iota-Beta, '92; Victor Heintz, Ohio, Ohio Epsilon, '96; Henry D. Flood, Virginia, Virginia Sigma, '86.

Previous issues of THE RECORD have contained sketches of all the foregoing except Brand, Denton, Swift, and Heintz. The three latter are the first initiates of our northern chapters to become members of the lower house of Congress.

Charles Hillyer Brand was born at Logansville, Georgia, April 20, 1861. He entered the University of Georgia, where he was initiated into the Fraternity in 1879, and was graduated from there in 1881. He was admitted to the bar in 1882. He has been twice married, both of his wives now being dead, and he has three daughters. In 1904-5 he was a member of the Georgia Senate, and its president *pro tempore*. He is a Mason, Pythian, and Elk, and was a bank president. He was solicitor general of the Western Judicial District of Georgia from 1896 to 1904. From 1906 to 1917 he was judge of the Superior Court of this circuit. He was elected as a Democrat from the eighth Georgia district to the Sixty-fifth Congress on January 11, 1917, receiving about 2,000 majority over his nearest opponent.

George Kirkpatrick Denton was born on a farm in Webster County, Kentucky, on November 17, 1864. He attended Ohio Wesleyan University, from which he was graduated in 1891. He there became a charter member of Ohio Delta, being initiated on November 17, 1888. He was graduated in 1893 from the Law Department of Boston University, and was one of the founders of Massachusetts Beta Upsilon. He was valedictorian of his class at

the latter institution. Since 1893 he practiced law at Evansville, Indiana, and was elected to the Sixty-fifth Congress from the first Indiana district as a Democrat by a plurality of 356 votes over his Republican opponent. He is married, and has a son and a daughter.

Oscar William Swift was born in Paines Hollow, New York, on April 11, 1869. He was graduated from the University of Michigan in 1892, where he was initiated into the fraternity on February 16, 1889. He was admitted to the New York bar in 1897, and has since that time been practicing law in New York City. He resides in Brooklyn, is married, and has four children. He was elected as a Republican from the ninth New York district to the Sixty-fourth Congress, his term commencing in 1915, and was reelected to the Sixty-fifth Congress.

Victor Heintz was born at Garyville, Illinois, on November 20, 1875. He was graduated from the University of Cincinnati in 1896, where he was initiated on September 27, 1892. He is a lawyer and unmarried. He was elected from the second Ohio district to the Sixty-fifth Congress as a Republican. He resides in Cincinnati.

In the congressional committees Senator Beckham is chairman of the Committee on Expenditures in the Department of Labor, and is a member of the Committee on Claims, Trespassers on Indian Lands, Library, Military Affairs, Philippines, Postoffices, and Post Roads, Public Buildings and Grounds, and Public Health and National Quarantine. Senator Knox is a member of the Committees on Corporations organized in the District of Columbia, Cuban Relations, Expenditures in the Treasury Department, Foreign Relations, Patents, Philippines, Privileges, and Elections and Rules. Senator Pittman is Chairman of the Committee on Territories, and a member of the Committees on Coast and Insular Survey, Expenditures in the Department of Justice, Foreign Relations, Indian Affairs, Irrigation and Reclamation of Arid Lands, Mines and Mining, Naval Affairs, and Public Lands.

In the House, Brand is a member of the Committees on Banking and Currency, Education and Revision of the Laws. Dent is Chairman of the Military Affairs Committee. Denton is a member of the Rivers and Harbors Committee. Harrison is a member of the Foreign Affairs and Rules Committees. Flood is Chairman of the Foreign Affairs Committee. At this writing Swift and Heintz have not yet received their committee assignments.

This is a representation of which the Fraternity may well be proud, and which adds to its laurels during these troubled times.

In keeping with the spirit of the times the Supreme Council of the Fraternity has decided to make "efficiency and economy" the slogan for the balance of this administration. That the two go hand in hand is self-evident, for a proper meaning of the **Efficiency and Economy** word economy is intelligent, systematic management of affairs, which can only result from efficiency. As you have no doubt observed, THE RECORD is much reduced in size. This is but one department in which a large saving will be made, and while it will necessitate eliminating general fraternity news, and most of our familiar departments, we shall endeavor to make THE RECORD an interesting chronicler of the glorious deeds of valor and sacrifice of Minerva's sons. Cheerfully do we bend to the need of the hour. Hopefully do we look to the future for an unselfish victory, without hate—a lasting peace based on "equality, liberty, and fraternity" for all the peoples of the earth. Kimball, among the coal barons, striving to obtain an equitable adjustment of the coal situation; Hobbs is not only giving much of his time to local Y. M. C. A. work, but will assist in a big drive in his state to raise money to

widen the war activity of that organization; Almy, as a member of one of the exemption boards in New York City, is putting in long hours in hearing and deciding the applications for exemption. Let us all get into the band wagon and do our bit to bring the war to an early and successful conclusion.
