

IN THE SERVICE

LMOST a year has flown by on the wings of time since the call to arms came to the virile young manhood of America. Much has happened in this time; history has been made which the perspective of years will write more clearly than is now possible. In the making of this history, men of Sigma Alpha Epsilon have done their part nobly and well. Hundreds, yes thousands, of the flower of our Fraternity elected to tread the paths that lead to glory and fame. With true patriotic fervor the sons of Minerva put on the martial armor that fell to their lot, whether the aeronaut's leather for spectacular flights over the lines of the enemy, or the more prosaic khaki in cantonments at home, preparing for greater things that may come in the future. There was no murmuring, no looking back, no regret, on the part of any of these men, but rather an enthusiasm, an eagerness to get into the thick of things, a will to win this war and secure forever the boon of liberty for the loved ones at home and for all the peoples of the earth who are oppressed by autocratic government. Combined with this eagerness and determination are "esprit de corps" and a contagious buoyancy of spirit, which the French soldiers also have, and which makes it possible for earnest men to "carry on" to the end of the war without the breaking of their morale. Not a man of our forces wants to quit his job before his work is done.

Glory has come all too soon to some of our brave brothers. We have word that two have made the supreme sacrifice on the fighting

fronts over there, while others as truly martyrs in the cause of world freedom have died in camps on this side of the Atlantic. Time alone can fill the gaps and complete this roster of honored dead, on which the first name to be inscribed is that of Gordon Stewart of Massachusetts Iota-Tau, who died in France on January 9, 1918, while serving as a cadet pilot in the American Aviation Section. The second name of which Sigma Alpha Epsilon may be proud is that of George A. Beach, also of Massachusetts Iota-Tau, who was instantly killed in an aviation accident in Italy on January 20, 1918.

Among the men at home who have given up their lives in the service of justice and humanity are M. A. Pharr of Georgia Phi, John W. Jewell of Missouri Alpha, and Robert K. Munn of Louisiana Tau-Upsilon. Pharr, 2nd Lieutenant, C. A. C., was accidentally killed at Fort Scriven. Munn, who was a private in Base Hospital No. 24, died at Fort Oglethorpe on February 1, 1918. Jewell was editor of Trench and Camp, the soldier's newspaper at Camp Funston. He was at the Army Bank there waiting for his chum, Kearney Wornall, also of Missouri Alpha, to finish his work as assistant cashier on the night of January 11, on which night a demented army captain robbed the bank and killed three men of the bank's force, beside Brother Jewell. Brother Wornall was left for dead, but in a few minutes recovered sufficiently to extricate himself from the ropes with which the robber had bound him and let a sentry know what had happened. The criminal committed suicide the next day when he realized that escape was impossible.

American Sanitary Section No. 5, in service along the western front, has been signally honored by the French military authorities in a manner that has attracted great attention to it throughout the French republic; it has been cited in orders three times in recognition of courageous actions, the third citation conferring the prized decoration of the "fourragere," this being the first bestowal of this honor on an ambulance section and on an American unit. Newman Ebersole, sergeant, and A. P. Preyer, private, both of New York Alpha, are members of this section of thirty-five men. They volunteered for Red Cross work in France in a group with twelve others under the auspices of the American Rolling Mills Company of Middletown, Ohio, and the groups was incorporated entire in the S. S. U. 5.

From a French village in an advanced sector from which the Boche has now been driven out, under the shadow of a huge gray

castle of the feudal period, Brother Ebersole wrote to his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Joseph G. Ebersole of Avondale, Ohio, the particulars of the honors won by the unit. "First was the order issued making each member of Section 5 an honorary member of the Alpine Chasseurs, which carries with it the privilege of wearing the 'Beret,' or distinctive cap of the Chasseurs. * * * *

"Next came the citation to the Order of the Army after the great battle and attack of October 23 and 26. There are several grades of citation, one from the head of a regiment, which is evidenced by the 'Croix de Guerre' with a bronze star, another by the general of the division, to which a silver star is attached, another by an army commander, for which the 'Palm Leaf' is the insignia. If the group should have received two palms it is then recommended to the commander-in-chief of all the armies, and maybe given the 'fourragere.' * * * * As our Section 5 had received the two decorations with the palms before this action, the record with all details was submitted to General Petain, Commander-in-chief of all the French Army, and I am sending a certified copy of his order No. 65 F, conferring his much-coveted decoration upon us. This is the highest military honor that the French government confers upon any unit or group of men acting together.

In addition, Brother Ebersole was awarded the "Croix de Guerre" individually for special bravery under fire.

A. L. Strehlke, of Massachusetts Gamma, is another of Minerva's sons who have been awarded the "Croix de Guerre," with star, for rescuing comrades from positions of peril, under fire.

Kimberly Stuart, of Massachusetts Iota-Tau, while serving with the French Army in the Balkans, won his "Croix de Guerre" on March 13, 1917. The order of citation states that "under the fire of the enemy he picked up and carried to his ambulance several wounded artillery men with the greatest calm and sangfroid." Last fall Brother Stuart took his examination as a naval aviator in Paris, and spent several weeks there at the Technology Club.

Two brothers from Bucknell, Leroy Clark and J. B. Vanderbilt, have just received the prized Croix de Guerre for gallant work in receiving wounded men during a heavy gas and shell attack.

Here at home word comes from college after college in the chapter letters that so many have gone that it will be necessary to close the chapter-house, which is the case at Florida State; or that the boys who remain are busied with attaching stars to their service flags; or that Uncle Sam is making use of their educational facilities for training men for the work on the other side. The chapter letter from Georgia School of Technology relates that "Uncle Sam is about to run us out of our school. He has taken over all the dormitories and there are soldiers everywhere. They are even running us out of our classrooms. But anything to beat the Kaiser. The ground aviation school has been moved to Texas, and in its place an aviation supply school is here. Also Tech has been made a Senior R. O. T. C. for the Engineering, Coast Artillery, and Signal Corps. Our guns, etc., will arrive shortly and the Military Department will be brought up to a high state of efficiency. Many of the brothers are preparing for a job with Uncle Sam at the close of school next June, while others have already joined. Bros. George Blackwell and Wilfred Gross have enlisted in the Signal Corps, and are detailed here at Tech as instructors in machine gun at the aviation school. Brothers Smith and McMillan have gone to Annapolis to prepare for entrance in the Naval Academy. Also brother Willingham has withdrawn from school to enter the service. Georgia Phi is certainly doing her bit in this war, for we already have a service flag with fifty-two stars in it and the number is growing all the time."

From Stanford comes a similar story of a service flag with numerous stars, as many as any other fraternity on the campus, and more of the men are preparing to enter the Navy or the Army.

Tennessee Nu's correspondent reports that Brother Davis has entered an aviation school, and Brother Tuley the third R. O. T. C., and adds with pride that the chapter has sixteen service stars in its flag, representing only last year's and this year's chapters. Letters from the blue grass state tell how Brothers Evans and Compton, of Kentucky Iota, who received commissions at the first Officers' Training Camp, have recently been promoted, and that Bro. J. R. Martin received his commission at the second camp. Bro. W. C. Repass of the same chapter has sailed for France as a 1st lieutenant in aviation. Kentucky Kappa has had its enthusiasm fired by the receipt of a letter from "Billy" Caldwell from Somewhere in France with the Engineers. He says he has met many Σ A E brothers, over there.

The new chapters in the West are not to be outdone by any of those longer established. Wyoming Alpha boasts that practically every man in the chapter is in some branch of the national service, a large proportion of them being already in France. Moreover, it is added, the University of Wyoming has furnished more men to the service in proportion to its enrollment than any other university in the United States. Arizona Alpha also is proud to report its military achievements. Brothers Downey, Gilbert, and Pierce, all juniors, had appointments to the third R. O. T. C. and all went to Camp Kearney after the holidays. Among the men in the National Army at Camp Funston, Brothers Estill, Pickrell, Penrod, and Sherrer were chosen for the R. O. T. C., and gave up sergeancies to try for something higher. Brother Weber also was appointed, but is to be transferred to an aviation school. Bro. Turner Smith is now in an engineer officers' school near Washington, having been transferred from Camp Funston. Brother Lesher, in the Marine Corps in France, was promoted to a first lieutenancy, as was Brother McSherry at the Presidio in San Francisco.

Pennsylvania Omega has three men at Camp Hancock in Georgia: Gamble, a lieutenant-colonel; Williams, a major, judge advocate; and Robinson, a first lieutenant. Brother Trace is reported to be flying in Texas, and Phillips is at Camp Sherman in Ohio. The chapter has had a letter from Brother Isherwood, who sailed for France last May with the Lakeside Base Hospital Unit. He has been recommended for a commission in the Regular Army; in his letter he tells of meeting Billy Levere and having a long talk. He says that Billy is doing great work over there and is beloved by all the soldiers.

Harry Petree, of Washington City Rho, got into a tail spin while "soloing" on the aviation field at Mineola last September and fell about a hundred feet. The Ambulance Corps rushed out to get him, but when they arrived he got up and asked them what the trouble was. Tom Noonan, also of that chapter, met some of the boys on the street in Paris a month or so ago, and asked them to come out to his home. Their surprise can well be imagined, when he explained that since going over with the Aviation Corps he had decided to be married, and with his bride had set up housekeeping in Paris.

Capt. A. W. Carnduff, Indiana Gamma, was one of the first men commissioned in the Ordnance Reserve Corps and has now been ordered to one of the base depots in France. Word has just been received that Bion Brown, Illinois Psi-Omega, has sustained slight wounds in action.

PROVINCE IOTA CONVENTION

Held at Knoxville, Tennessee, December 20, 21, and 22, 1917

P ROVINCE IOTA met in its seventh biennial convention at Knoxville, Tennessee, December 20, 1917. The tragedy of the great war was forcibly brought home to the convention when Tennessee Kappa reported forty-seven stars in its service flag and other chapters reported proportionately large numbers.

The convention was, as one would naturally infer from the stars in the flags, not largely attended by the "Old Guard" and the delegates were the youngest in point of collegiate attendance perhaps in the history of the province, as many of the delegates were from the freshman class. However, these delegates were of a serious turn of mind and took right hold of the situation as they had done in their chapters when they found their ranks depleted by the brothers answering the roll call of Uncle Sam and when the convention had completed its duties and adjourned, it was pronounced by the older men present to be one of the best province gatherings in their memory.

Of the province officials, only the Archon was left, the Deputy Archon and the Recorder and Treasurer having joined the colors. In the chapters, conditions were equally unfavorable, as hardly enough old men with fraternity experience were left in the chapters to organize for active duty, the ranks of the chapters having been depleted to fill the ranks of Uncle Sam.

The convention went into session at the St. James Hotel promptly at 2 o'clock, P. M., December 20, with the Province Archon presiding. Robert B. Snowden, of Tennessee Kappa, welcomed the delegates and visitors to Knoxville, and J. H. Ringgold, of Kentucky Iota, responded for the visiting brothers.

The convention discussed many serious matters affecting the chapters brought about by the war. All the chapters, as well as their schools, were hard hit by the war, as each chapter is not only trying to do its "bit" but its level best to help win the struggle. As already said, Tennessee Kappa reported forty-seven men in the service up to December 20, and others had made applications to enter. John A. Ayres, acting Recorder and Treasurer of the Province in the absence of Flem Hazen who had joined the colors, had just received orders to prepare to report to the Third Officers'

Training Camp. Likewise, other chapters reported a large number of men in the service and others preparing to enter.

Beside furnishing men for the front, the Province is doing its "bit" in helping maintain the men who are at the front. For this purpose, the Province subscribed for four one-hundred dollar Liberty Bonds of the second issue and some of the chapters had made similar loans to the Government—all endeavoring to help win the war.

This was the spirit that ruled the convention and which the brothers carried back anew to their chapters.

EDITORIAL COMMENT

With no more confusion than is necessarily incidental to such events, there has been a change in the editorship of The Record. The change, however, is merely one of personnel, not of policy.

Elmer B. Sanford resigned to take effect January 15,

A Change 1918, and the present Editor was appointed by the Supreme Council to fill the unexpired term.

The change above noted is the only one that occurs in the Editorial Board. It is a fortunate circumstance that the five Associate Editors, Roscoe C. Chambers, James E. Chapman, Herbert M. Martin, Roy D. Pinkerton, and Charles C. Thomas, who have heretofore assisted in the work of The Record can see their way clear to continue in the same capacity. Two new associates have been added, James E. Chappell, managing editor of the Birmingham (Alabama) News, and Arthur Nye Van Vleck, lieutenant, Ordnance Corps, in Washington. Brother Chappell will bring to the Editorial Board the benefit of a large experience in journalism and Brother Van Vleck will supply an intimate acquaintanceship with the varied activities in Washington.

In retiring from the editorship of The Record, Elmer B. Sanford can look back upon a long service in the official life of the Fraternity—a service which dates practically from the time of his initiation. As a member of Michigan Iota Beta he represented Elmer B. the chapter in its relations with the fraternity publi-Sanford This was the beginning of an interest which soon resulted in his being placed at the head of the Editorial Board of THE RECORD. In 1902 while attending the Washington convention, he met Henry Sydnor Harrison, then Editor of THE RECORD. and through this acquaintance and the offer of Sanford's services to him, he was appointed Exchange Editor of THE RECORD. position he held until he was appointed Editor in 1910 to fill the unexpired term of Charles P. Wood. Since that date he has been elected to the editorship at four successive conventions, 1910, 1912, 1914, and 1916.

The thing that Sanford is most proud of in his fraternity activity is his connection with the life subscription plan. When this plan

was first called to his attention it enlisted his immediate support and it fell to his lot to draw the law which was passed at the Nashville convention.

In 1902 Sanford organized a local at the University of Kansas for the purpose of petitioning Sigma Alpha Epsilon. He represented the petitioners at the Washington convention and a charter was granted at that time.

Sanford has been president of the Kansas City Alumni Association and also served as president of Province Zeta for two terms. He has attended every national convention from 1902 to the Pittsburgh convention in 1916 and was the delegate to the Interfraternity Congress for 1916 and 17.

The increased responsibilities imposed upon him and the greater demands on his time, as counsel for the Long Island Lighting Company and its allied companies, have practically compelled Sanford to give up his active official association with the Fraternity. The hundreds of men in the Fraternity who know him will hear with pleasure of the larger field of legal work into which he has entered and will wish him an unstinted and ungrudging measure of success.

The Honor Roll published in this issue makes a creditable showing of the members of \(\Sigma \) A E who are in the military or naval service. But it is not complete. It is probably safe to say that there are from 500 to 1,000 men in the service whose names do not appear. The reasons therefor are obvious, but not satisfactory: the chapters are the main sources of information but the chapters, particularly with all of the older and more widely acquainted members, away, are not in close touch with the alumni. Consequently, many of the alumni have entered the service and their former chapters have heard nothing of it, and the chapter report is deprived of an essential item.

The Honor Roll will be a standing feature of The Record during the period of the war. In this way it is hoped to make an effective appeal for corrections and additions. The assistance of every member of the Fraternity is requested in the effort to make the roll accurate and complete.

The Honor Roll tells its own story in a matter-of-fact way, but it does not record the achievements of the men whose names appear there. To supply this latter, it will be the purpose to publish in each issue a "service story" in connection with the honor roll, wherein there will be set forth the notable feats connected with the military or naval life of the members. This part of The Record's work

will depend almost entirely upon the widest coöperation of the members everywhere, and it is requested that items of interest, letters, newspaper clippings, postcards, etc., be sent to the Editor. On account of the limited space available, they will in most cases be dealt with briefly in the "service story" but after the reference is made they will be transferred to the permanent offices of the Fraternity at Evanston and filed for any future use for historical purposes.

The members of the Fraternity are rendering war service in other ways than with the military and naval forces—on the draft boards, in the Y. M. C. A. ranks, in the Ambulance Corps, in the departments at Washington, and elsewhere. It is the desire to record the name of every such member on the pages of The Record and the nature and place of his work.

For their patient and painstaking assistance in the preparation of the Honor Roll The Record is indebted to Miss S. Elizabeth Reynolds and Miss Sara A. Dyer of the Bureau of War Risk Insurance, Washington, D. C.

The point of view may have something to do with whether one calls it a privilege or a burden, but it is nevertheless true that no chapter in the Fraternity has ever found itself in the position which Washington City Rho now occupies. Since the war began \(\Sigma\) A Es have come to or passed through Washington by scores, perhaps by hundreds. Many of them drop in at the house in a casual manner and pass on; others repeat their visits and become thoroughly acquainted; still others have "stuck around" and established a sort of lien on the dining table, to say nothing of exercising the right of eminent domain on all the accessories.

The tide is flowing away from all the other chapters, but it is flowing toward Washington City Rho. Not in new members, but in old members who are renewing their life in the chapter-house. To say that the Washington City Rho chapter-house has been a veritable haven for numerous Σ A Es, is putting it mildly, while on the other hand it is only fair to say that these self-same Σ A Es have been a welcome boon to Washington City Rho. The chapter-house has furnished a home and a friendly atmosphere that the men could not have found elsewhere under the present conditions in Washington, and it must be said to the credit of the chapter that, without taking the slightest advantage of the situation, they have established themselves on a firm and steady financial foundation.

IN MEMORIAM



GORDON STEWART

The Fraternity has recently realized a great loss in the death of Bro. Gordon Stewart of Massachusetts Iota-Tau Chapter who died in France on January 9, while serving in the American Aviation Section as a cadet pilot.

Brother Stewart was born on March 15, 1896. During his freshman year in 1916, at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology he entered the American Ambulance Section.

Many interesting facts concerning his career in the service have been obtained from his letters. In a letter dated May 23, he tells of an accident in which he broke his left arm. At this time, he was taken to the hospital at D'Arc'en Barrois. It was necessary to use anesthesia four times for the setting. All of these operations were unfortunate in that the bones assumed such a position that serious complications resulted. After twelve weeks in the hospital, he returned to the Ambulance Section on August 9, and remained there until October 14, at which time his term of service expired. He immediately went to Paris and enlisted in the American Aviation Section as a cadet pilot. He made his first loop while driving his aeroplane one-handed.

During the summer of 1917 his arm gradually became worse and at last developed paralysis, starting in his fingers and extending up the arm. It was about October that he wrote of how his arm was fast becoming useless. Early in January he was sent back to the hospital, where he died on January 9.

As far as can be determined, Brother Stewart is the first Σ A Ξ to make this great sacrifice in the service of his country against Germany.

Such was the cablegram which brought the news of the death of one of Sigma Alpha Epsilon's most brilliant and loyal sons.

George Albert Beach was born in Fort Collins, Colorado, twenty-five years ago. He was educated in the public schools there and attended the Colorado State College for one year. He graduated from the Massachusetts

Institute of Technology in 1914 with one of the highest records in the Institute's history.

Brother Beach was initiated into the Massachusetts Iota Tau Chapter of Sigma Alpha Epsilon on November 18, 1911. His fraternity career was no less brilliant than his scholastic. He filled most creditably several fraternity offices and served the chapter very efficiently in the office of E.A. in the fall of 1913.

When war was declared it seemed only natural that Brother Beach should be in the front rank. He was in the first squadron at the Army Aviation School at M. I. T. and at the end of four weeks was chosen with four others to be sent to France to flying school so that he might return to America as an instructor. From France he was sent to Italy and had completed the last brevit of the Italian system, had been recommended, and was awaiting commission when he took the flight which was his last.

Sigma Alpha Epsilon has given her best in accordance with her ancient traditions. With Brother Beach's death comes a sense of immeasurable loss but at the same time a feeling of great inspiration. As far as we know, Brother Beach was the second Σ A E to lose his life in the service of his country in the present war.

JOSEPH H. THOMPSON

Joseph H. Thompson, one of the foremost citizens of Nashville, Tennessee, acknowledged leader in business and civic enterprises and perhaps the greatest giver to charity and public institutions Nashville has known and one of the most prominent members of the Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternity died suddenly on Sunday morning, March 18, 1917. Heart failure was assigned as the cause of his death.

Mr. Thompson was born on January 14, 1854, the second son of Mr. John and Mrs. Mary Hamilton Thompson.

After receiving a sound preparatory education he attended the University at Nashville and Cumberland University. At the latter institution he took a degree in law. He was a student of fine habits and cheerful disposition, and stood very high with his professors and with the other students.

On February 14, 1875, he married Miss Ella Vaughn, a daughter of Mr. Michael Vaughn. Of this union there were born three children, Mrs. Gordon Payne of Baltimore, Mrs. Henry Dickinson of Memphis, and a son, Joseph H. Thompson, Jr., who died in infancy. Mrs. Thompson died June 6, 1896.

In January, 1899, Mr. Thompson married Miss Willie DeMoville, the daughter of Mrs. Felix DeMoville. Of this union there is one son, Joseph H. Thompson, Jr., who is attending the Notre Dame College at South Bend, Indiana.

Few men have had so remarkable a business career as did Mr. Thompson. His activities radiated to a multitude of affairs and that he was able to give minute care to the details of so many affairs was a marvel to those with whom he was associated.

For a number of years Mr. Thompson was a member of the county court, and was one of the most active members. He possessed an intimate knowledge of law, and it is said that he practically shaped the policy of the county court while he was a member of that body.

Mr. Thompson was a recognized leader in every charitable, educational, or institutional campaign inaugurated in Nashville and devoted a large portion of his time to these affairs. To them he gave liberally of his money, in many instances bearing heavily the burden of the contributions.

The keynote to his character was absolute sincerity. He believed not in evasions, in false standards, but believed in a man living his life for the best there was in him and to be of service, if he could, to others as well as himself. He was an earnestly religious man, and was an elder of the First Presbyterian Church. He was a man of very quiet demeanor; he could maintain an unruffled disposition in the face of trying circumstances and great provocation, was free from ostentation, and yet he was the guiding spirit of any coterie of men with whom he associated. Leadership came to him naturally, and while modest to a degree he willingly took on burden after burden.

Few men of any time have ever attained a like versatility in handling complex affairs, and the majority of men would have broken down utterly in health and mind had they undertaken only a portion of the work accomplished by him.

I knew Mr. Thompson intimately from the date of my initiation in 1898, and have always thought of him as the most striking example of those men who modestly, quietly, and without any public show, make their lives of daily service to the Fraternity. Mr. Thompson stood behind the scenes, so to speak and prompted the Fraternity from the day of his initiation to the time of his death. Throughout my college days, as well as the many years of alumni life in the city of Nashville, I never saw him fail to respond to the call of the Fraternity and he did so in that cheerful, whole-hearted way that made every member of the active chapter, as well as the alumni, love him. He supported without exception every chapter movement and every alumni movement of Σ A Ξ in the city of Nashville and his unerring judgment steered the Fraternity safely past many breakers.

Mr. Thompson was initiated in 1872 by Tennessee Mu which was then domiciled at the University of Nashville but later transferred to Vanderbilt University. After leaving the University of Nashville, he took up law at Cumberland University and affiliated with Tennessee Lambda. He was president of the Nashville Alumni Association, except for a very short interval, for the past twenty years, and was at the time of his death president both of the Nashville Alumni Association of Σ A E and the Sigma Alpha Epsilon Corporation. In the latter capacity he was one of the moving spirits in building the new home for the Fraternity at Vanderbilt University.
